○ ASSESSMENT consists of:

Assignment (30% of total marks) - on the final day candidates will deliver a 30 minute presentation based on their handling of a case study provided in advance.

Skills Demonstration (70%) – learners will be asked to practice a number of skills learned in the workplace - to be submitted as a written report within 2 weeks of course end.

Full guidance and support will be provided to learners.
